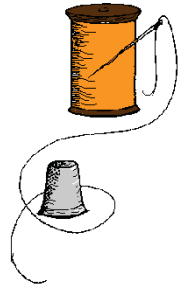

The supply list:

- 1 1/3 yards Border stripe fabric
- 1 yard backing fabric
- 1/2 yard binding fabric
- 1 yard batting

DO NOT PREWASH YOUR FABRIC.

Quilt Bingo for the January 26 Meeting

Several years ago Jean Poulton created a Quilt Bingo game that we enjoyed playing and that resulted in 3 charity quilts made from the bingo cards. We're planning to play Bingo again at the January 26 meeting (following our annual Garage Sale).

Each member is asked to make one fabric Bingo block with 2 1/2 inch squares. (Overachievers may make more than one!!) The Club will provide the center "FREE" square. At the November and December meetings we'll have sample blocks for you to see and a direction sheet for making the columns. You should take as many center FREE squares for the number of blocks you plan to make. (We'll use additional fabric from the FREE squares for our quilt sashing).

Once you make your block or blocks you need to bring them to the January 26 meeting along with some **BUTTONS** to use as your bingo markers. That's easy!

I'm looking for several members to volunteer to put the charity quilts together (after the January meeting). Consider giving us a hand with this project. Let me know if you'd like to help.
