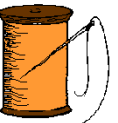
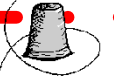

Bring your sewing machine, supplies, and projects, as well as an iron and pad and extension cord(s)/power strip(s). The church has one (1) iron and board, but we need to supply the rest. Restaurants and Wegmans are close and you may use the small kitchen in the sewing area and bring your own food. Please bring a snack to share with the group. Cost is \$5/day.

Directions: If you are coming from Irondequoit on route 104, take the first exit after crossing the Bay Bridge, which is Bay Road. Turn right, heading north onto Bay Road and the church is only ½ mile further up the road on the left.

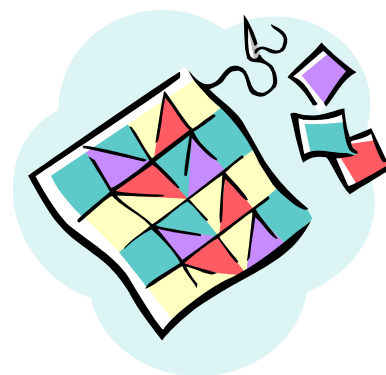

Minutes of the Irondequoit Quilt Club (IQC) Monday, November 17, 2014

Co-President Donna German called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Vice-President Georgia Sadler introduced the evening's speaker, Linda Hunter, who spoke on the topic of "How to Make an Award-winning Quilt." She talked about different quilt categories in a quilt show and presented different quilts and wall hangings to illustrate her talk. Her informative presentation was well-received by the members. Linda Hunter is also an AQS certified quilt appraiser.

Georgia Sadler talked about making Bingo cards from fabric scraps. She showed an example of a finished card and distributed the Free Space and directions to members who were interested in making these cards. Bingo using these cards will be played at our January meeting.

Jeanne Muhl spoke about the club doing a memorial for Mimi Repp, a longtime IQC member, who passed away this month. Since Mimi worked in an elementary school, Jeanne offered the idea of making books to give to a school in Mimi's memory. Jeanne will discuss the memorial with Earl Repp, Mimi's husband, to see what the family feels would be a good memorial to Mimi.
