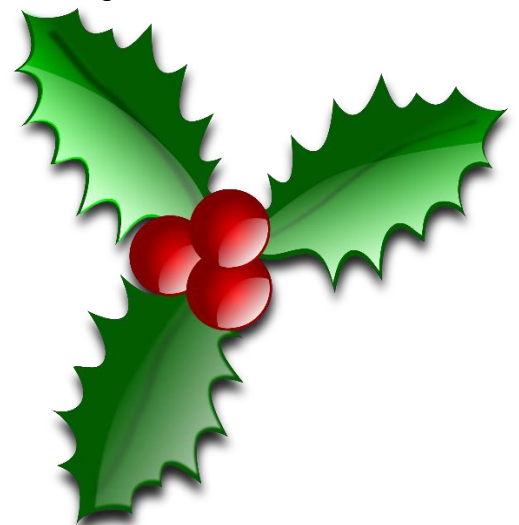
IQC Meeting Minutes-September 28, 2015
