## Charity Coordination – Lucy Donalies

Our November meeting will be **Charity Night**. We will be completing Charity Quilts for distribution for Christmas. We will also be sewing Christmas Stockings for the Irondequoit Food Cupboard. To work on these tasks, please bring one or two the following items:

- Sewing machine to sew binding on completed quilts.
- Serger machine to sew Christmas stockings.
- Hand sewing needles and/or sewing kit.
- Scissors for trimming quilts, trimming threads and hand sewing.

We also will need help with ironing:

- Press binding
- Press Christmas Stockings

I have had some requests for the sizes of Charity Quilts that are needed. Here are the Charities we are supporting and size quilts they prefer:

- St John's Home – Lap quilts 36" x 48" (can use fleece) & Walker bags with wide straps & Velcro
- Bivona Child Advocacy – Quilts in various sizes- - Lap to twin (can be fleece)
- Meals on Wheels – Lap quilts 36" x 48" and 36" x 60" (can use fleece)
- Mary Cariola Center – Lap quilts for children in wheelchairs in 3 sizes: 24" x 36", 36" x 48", 36" x 60"
- Villa of Hope – Twin size bed quilts for 12-18 years old
- Quilts of Valor – Approximately 55" wide x 75" in length. We are also making quilts from 12" finished blocks (12 ½" unfinished)

We will be completing about 60 quilts at our meeting. Thank you for helping with this important task. See you at the meeting.
