

Gift-Card Holder

Use your holiday scraps to dress up a gift card and make it personal.

SPECIFICATIONS

Skill Level: Beginner
Holder Size: Approximately
4" x 2¾" folded

MATERIALS

- 2 (5" x 9") rectangles coordinating fabric
- 5" x 9" rectangle fusible web on release paper
- Thread
- 5" x 9" rectangle freezer paper
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

HOLDER ASSEMBLY

1. Iron the fusible web rectangle to the wrong side of one 5" x 9" fabric rectangle.
2. Let cool; remove release paper, and with wrong sides together, fuse the second 5" x 9" fabric rectangle to the fused one to make a double-layered rectangle with right sides facing out.
3. Trace the pattern given onto the freezer-paper rectangle and iron onto the fused rectangle unit.
4. Trim around the freezer paper to create the holder shape.
5. Mark and cut slit open.
6. Fold up bottom flap at the No. 1 fold line and press.
7. Stitch ¼" along open side edges and around top edge of top flap in one seam referring to Figure 1.

8. Fold and press the top flap down along the No. 2 fold line; insert tip of top flap into slit on bottom flap and press to finish. **QW**

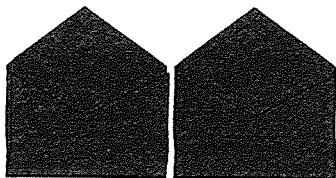
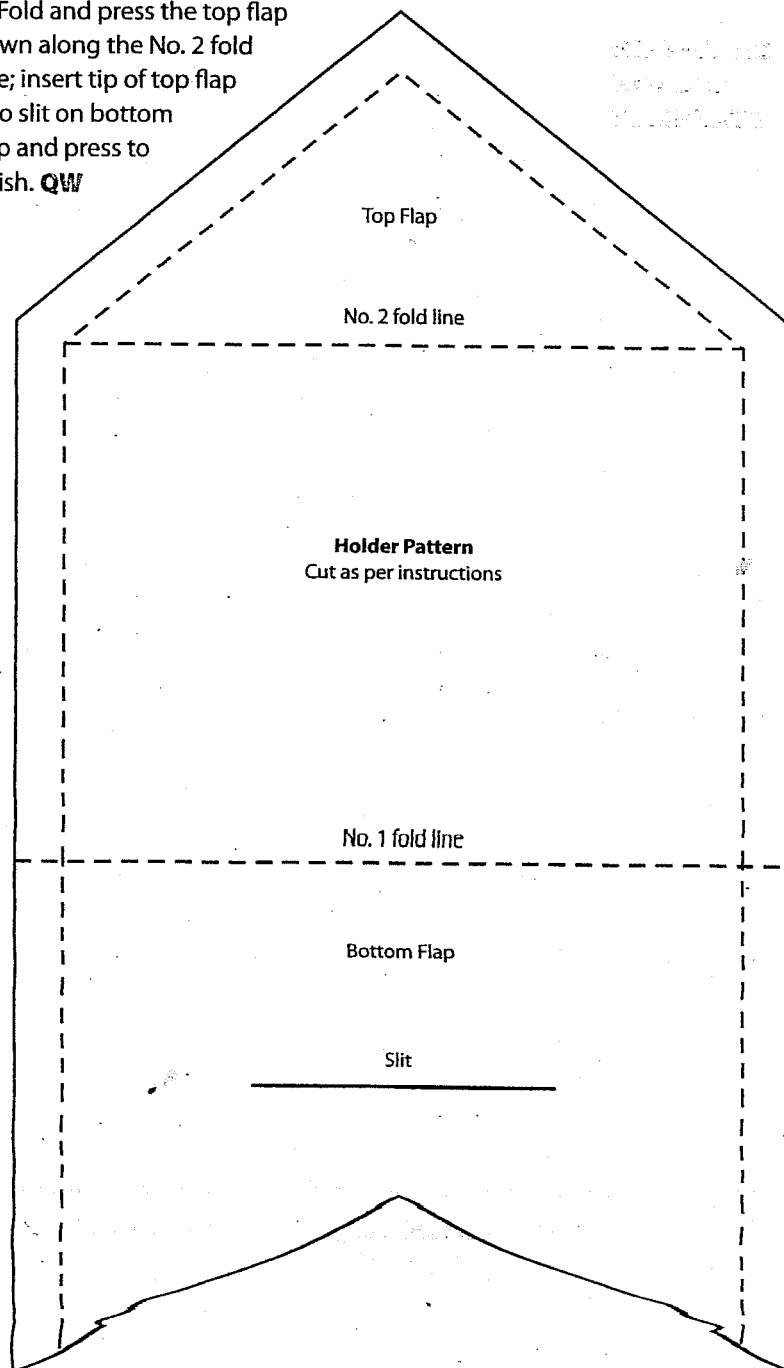
