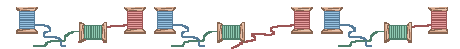

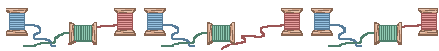
Rooms are \$115 per person – based on 4 people per room

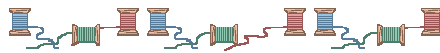
Opportunity Quilt Sign-up

February Meeting Supplies

Different aspects of hand sewing: If you want to participate, please bring the following:

A 12 ½ inch square with a basket on it, a free hand appliqué was distributed at the meeting, but any type of basket could be appliquéd on using whatever method works

best for you. This will be the base of the project.

Fabric Folding Flowers

6 ½ inch fabric squares, needle, thread, pressing bar

Fabric Ruching Flowers

Fabric squares in various sizes (2", 2 ½", 4", 5", 6", 7"), 1 ½" strip of fabric, pencil for marking, needle, coordinating thread, scissors

Silk Ribbon Embroidery

Silk ribbon, ribbon embroidery needle

(Note: there was concern about availability of items so consider them optional)

Embellishments

Buttons, embroidery thread, rickrack, yarns
All these techniques will be used to transform your basket block into a lovely spring basket.
