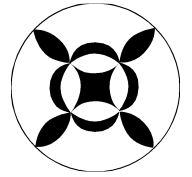

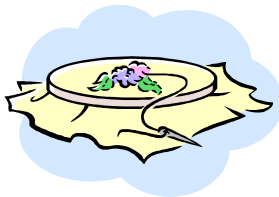


Sew Nights
