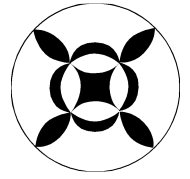

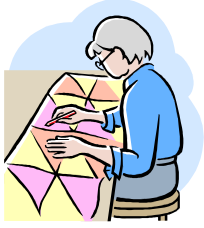
Brenda's Caps
